

Zocor Medication Contraindications and Prescribing Information

ZOCOR is the brand name for Simvastatin - is a cholesterol-lowering drug that belongs to the statin class of drugs. Side effects of Zocor that you should report to your doctor as soon as possible are:

- •allergic reactions like skin rash, itching or hives, swelling of the face, lips, or tongue
- •dark urine
- •fever
- •joint pain
- •muscle cramps, pain
- •redness, blistering, peeling or loosening of the skin, including inside the mouth
- •trouble passing urine or change in the amount of urine
- •unusually weak or tired
- •yellowing of the eyes or skin

Side effects that usually do not require medical attention (report to your doctor if they continue or are troublesome):

- •constipation
- •stomach gas, pain, upset
- •heartburn

 Do not take Zocor with any of the following medications:

- •medicines for fungal infections like itraconazole, ketoconazole
- •nefazodone
- •other medicines for high cholesterol
- •red yeast rice
- •some antibiotics like clarithromycin, erythromycin, telithromycin
- •some medicines for HIV infection like amprenavir, indinavir, ritonavir

 Zocor medicine may also interact or have contraindications with the following items and medications:

- •alcohol
- •grapefruit juice
- •amiodarone
- •cyclosporine
- •danazol
- •diltiazem
- •fluconazole
- •verapamil
- •warfarin
- •voriconazole
